Mikhail Smirnov, Artistic Director/Founder of Ensemble Barynya, was born in Moscow. He has been involved in Russian folk dance and music for more than 25 years, and has authored many articles about traditional Russian dance, music and instruments in English and Russian. He received his Master's degree from Moscow State University of Culture and Arts. As a child, he was a member of the famous "Moscow Boys Chorus," one of the most prestigious all-male choirs in Russia, and was a soloist in several Russian folk groups including the Moscow State Center. Through extensive study and travel, Mikhail discovered influences of regional music traditions, which informed the repertoire of Barynya. He was featured, along with ensemble dancers of Barynya, on NBC's "Superstars of Dance," where he was also honored to be a judge on the panel.



Barynya Musical Director and balalaika virtuoso Elina Karokhina was born in

Leningrad (now St. Petersburg), Russia. Her formal training was at prestigious schools: Mussorgsky Music College-St. Petersburg, and Rimsky-Korsakov St. Petersburg State Conservatory, earning a degree as an Orchestra Soloist. She studied under the famous performer and composer, Alexander Shalov, and had the honor of premiering several of his compositions. Elina was the last graduate student of Mr. Shalov. She has won many competitions and traveled extensively as she performs around the world. Recently, Elina was invited to perform as Honored Guest Artist at the Balalaika and Domra Association of America 40th Jubilee Convention in Philadelphia.



Choreographer Valentina Kvasova specializes in Russian, Cossack, Ukrainian, and Russian Roma Gypsy traditional dances. She was born in Rostov-na-Donu, Russia, into a family of musicians. After completing formal education at Voronezh Choreographic School, she was invited to Rostov Don Cossacks State Academic Song and Dance Ensemble where she quickly rose in rank to soloist. International tours include Japan, Spain, Hungary, the republic of South Africa, and the US, among others. Also a talented vocalist, Valentina has mastered a wide range of leading roles of lyrical, playful, comic characters. Her diverse repertoire includes Cossack, Bulgarian and Russian-Gypsy songs, arranged and performed with respect for tradition.
